

# How to Redirect to a Specific URL on Form Submission

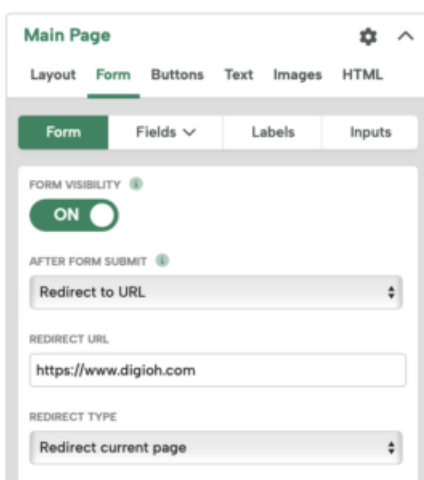

## What You'll Learn in This Article:

- How to configure your Digioh form to redirect users to a specific URL upon submission.
- Best practices for ensuring a seamless redirection experience for your users.

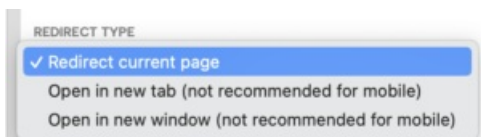
After a form submission, you may want to redirect visitors to a specific page. This is particularly helpful if you have specific tracking requirements.

To redirect to a certain URL (and bypass the Digioh Thank You page in your campaign), follow the steps outlined:

1. From the Digioh editor, choose the **Form** tab. Make sure the **Form Visibility** is ON.
2. Set the **After Form Submit** dropdown to **Redirect to URL**
3. Enter the URL for the page you wish to redirect your users to. Make sure to include `https://` in your URL.
4. Choose the **Redirect Type**. The redirect can open in the same window, a new window, or a new tab. The **Redirect current page** option will open the URL in the browser window the visitor is currently using. **Open in new tab** will open the URL in a new tab, and **Open in new window** will open the URL in a new window.

In most cases, we recommend either redirecting the current page or opening a new tab. Redirects that open in new browser windows are often blocked by adblockers.

Then just save and publish your campaign, and your form will now redirect to the desired link!
