

How to Prevent All Pop ups from Being Triggered after One Was Submitted

Say you have multiple pop ups running in your account, but you want to stop displaying all pop ups to users who have previously submitted any pop up. This makes sense if you only have one email list or are a B2B company.

Our Sitewide Rules make it easy to do this.

Step 1: Go to Sitewide Rules by Clicking "More" on the Campaign List UI, then "Sitewide Rules."

Step 2: Select the option "Do Not Show Campaigns After Form Submission."

Sitewide Rules

Configure rules that apply to all boxes on your site. Individual boxes can have their own rules by selecting the conditions in which they should appear. You can view and update conditions by finding your box on the [Box List](#) page.

If boxes are NOT appearing on your site, this may be because of a Sitewide Rule setting.

- Ignore Sitewide Rules for "Inline" Forms** (Recommended)
This lets inline forms appear without blocking popups, sidebars, or banners.
- Limit to One Box per Pageview**
This ensures a visitor sees only one Box per pageview, no matter how many Boxes are set up.
- Limit to One Box per Session** (Not Recommended)
This ensures a visitor sees only one Box during their entire session, no matter how many pages they visit.
- Limit to One Box per Visitor** (Not Recommended)
This ensures a visitor sees only one Box, no matter how many pages or visits they have.
- Do Not Show Boxes After Form Submission** (Not Recommended)
This stops any more Boxes from appearing after a visitor submits a form, even on return visits.
- Allow Multiple Boxes to Display Simultaneously** (Advanced)
Turn this on to display more than one box at a time to visitors. Recommended only for advanced Digioh users.
- Do Not Show Boxes to Visitors with Disabled Cookies** (Advanced)
This prevents issues for visitors with cookies disabled.

Select this option
and Save & Publish
