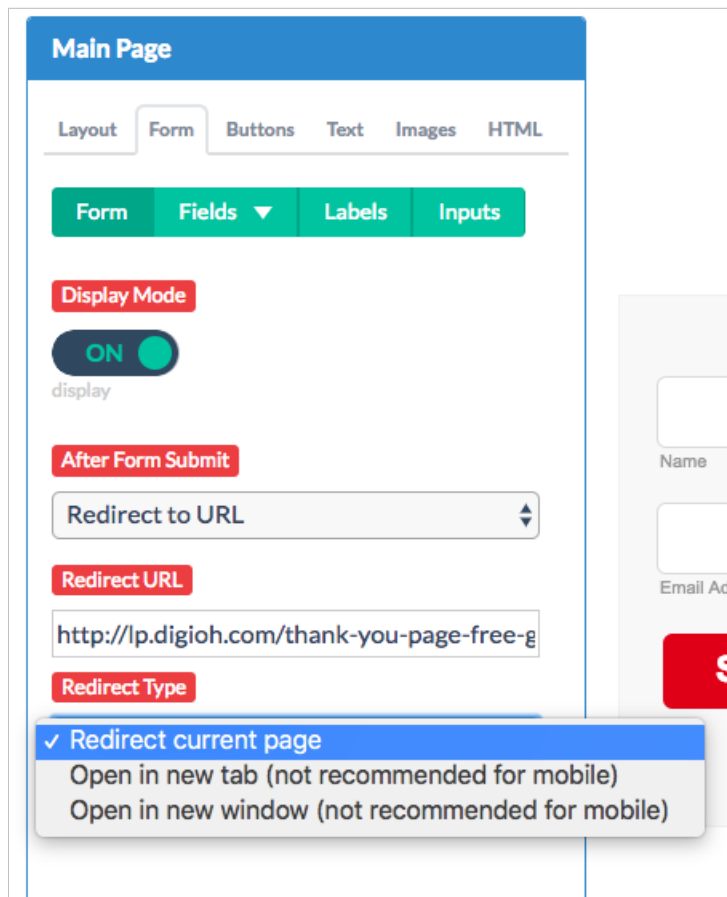


Why aren't my mobile re-directs working?

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Different mobile devices handle redirect links differently. If your mobile redirect isn't working, you may need to adjust your redirect settings.

If the Redirect Type field is set to "open in new tab" or "redirect in new window," the redirect link won't work on mobile devices with certain security settings enabled. To fix this, set the redirect to "redirect current page."

If you add a redirect link to an iTunes app store page, and the link isn't working on Apple mobile devices, this is related to a specific security setting within iOS dictating how it handles app store redirects.
