- Accurately adjust the size and position of elements to the nearest pixel.
- Effortlessly center elements within your designs.

Making updates to your Campaign Design

Select the element you want to position (the "Button 1" element in this example). Scroll down to see controls for Button Size and Button Position.



Button Size **Button Position**

The Button Size values control this element's width and height. The Button Position X and Y control the horizontal and vertical distance from the upper-left corner of your campaign (where the values are set to 0,0).

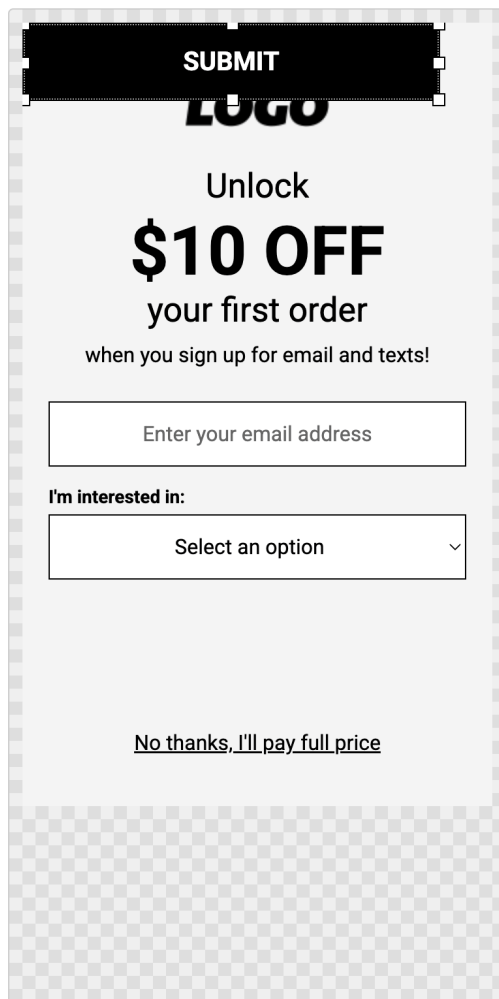

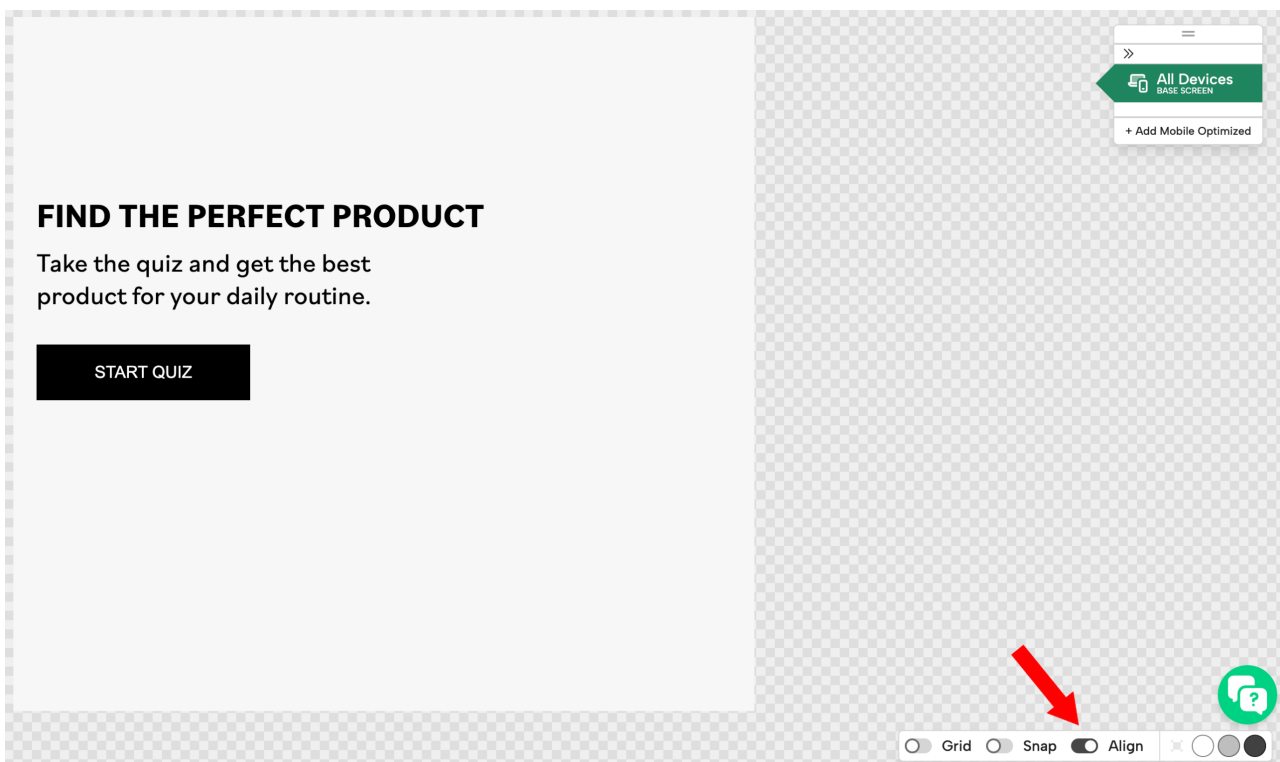


Want to make sure everything lines up just right? Toggle on the **Grid** in the bottom right corner of the campaign editor canvas. This overlays a clean 10×10 pixel grid to help you align your elements more easily by eye.

It's a simple visual guide, but super effective for keeping your design neat and consistent.



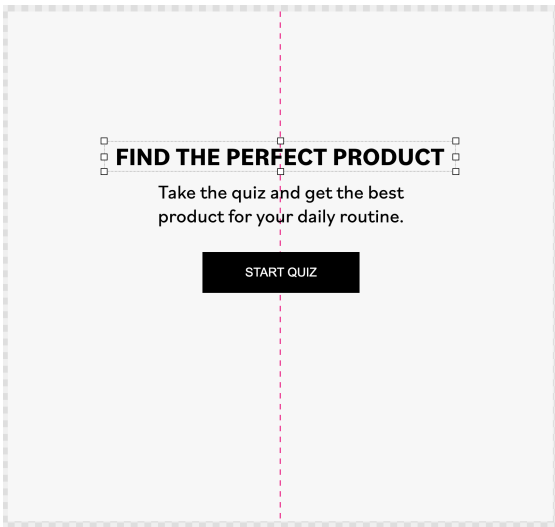
To align elements to each other, toggle Align on in the editor.



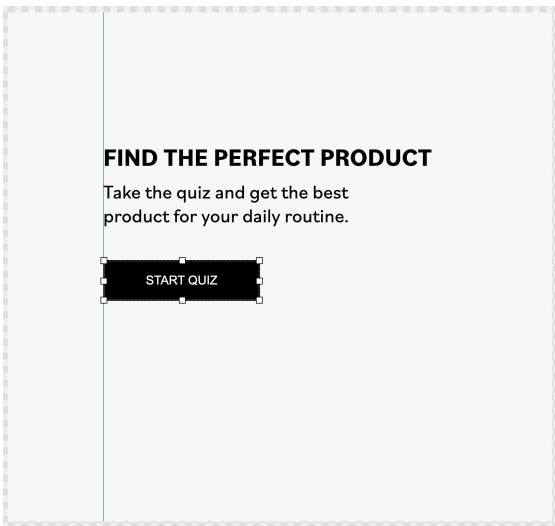
With Align enabled, dragging an element displays live horizontal and vertical alignment guides (the X and Y axes).

These guides appear when the moving element's edges or center line up with other elements or canvas anchors, so you can position items visually and precisely.

Pink dotted lines indicate alignment to the canvas



while solid blue lines indicate alignment to other elements.
