

How To Add Custom Fonts From Your Website To Digioh

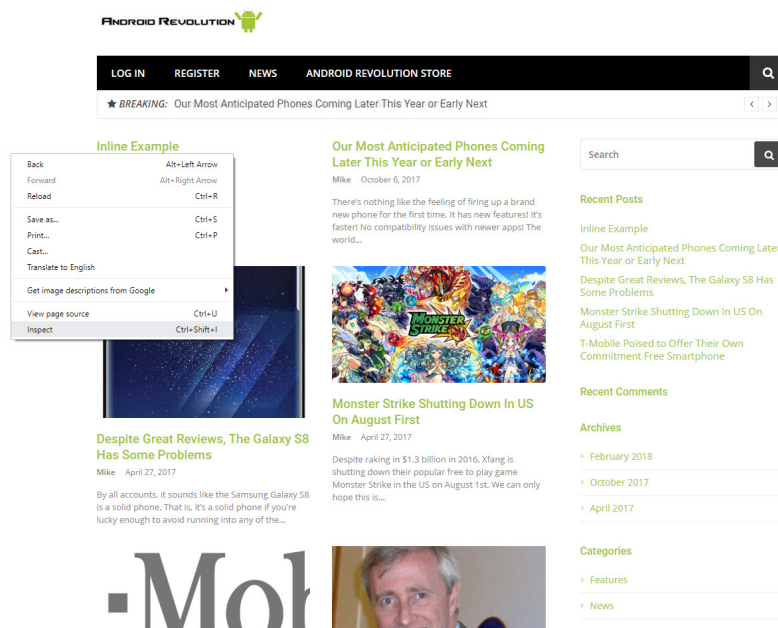
Digioh allows you to upload custom font files for use in your campaigns. If you want to use a font from your website in Digioh but don't have the font file, you can export the font from your website.

What You'll Learn

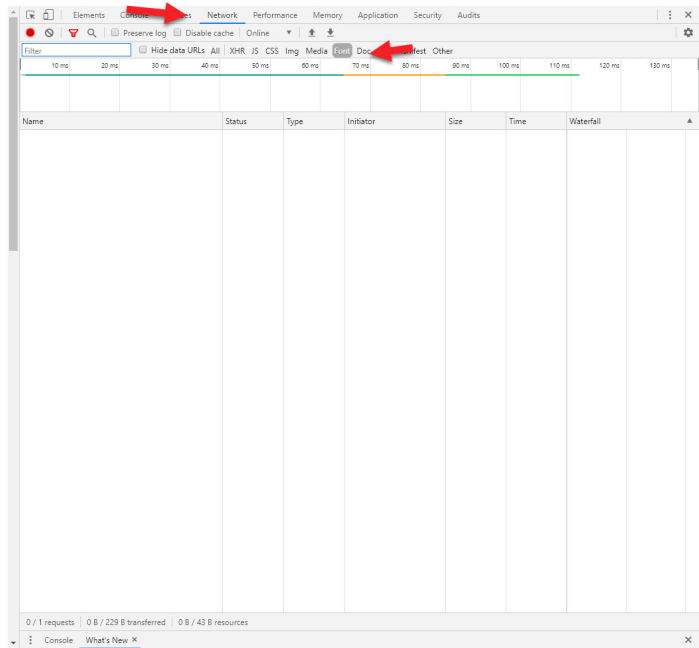
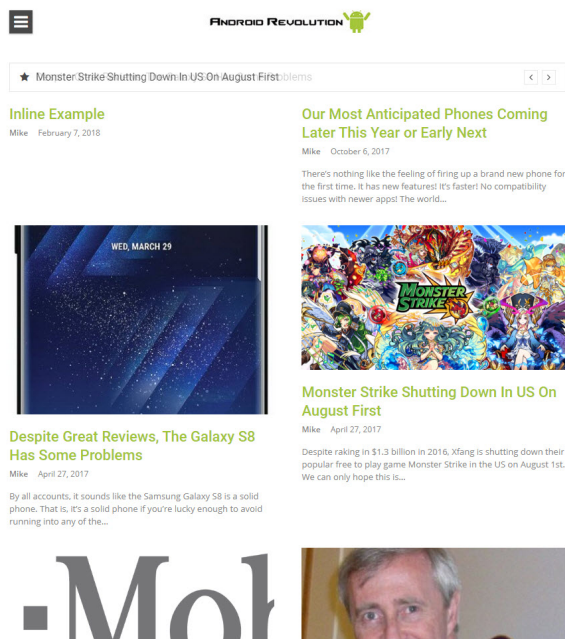
- Steps to download fonts from your website.
- Steps to upload the downloaded font file to your Digioh account.
- Identifying the correct font format to download.

Follow these steps to export your website's fonts and add them to your Digioh account.

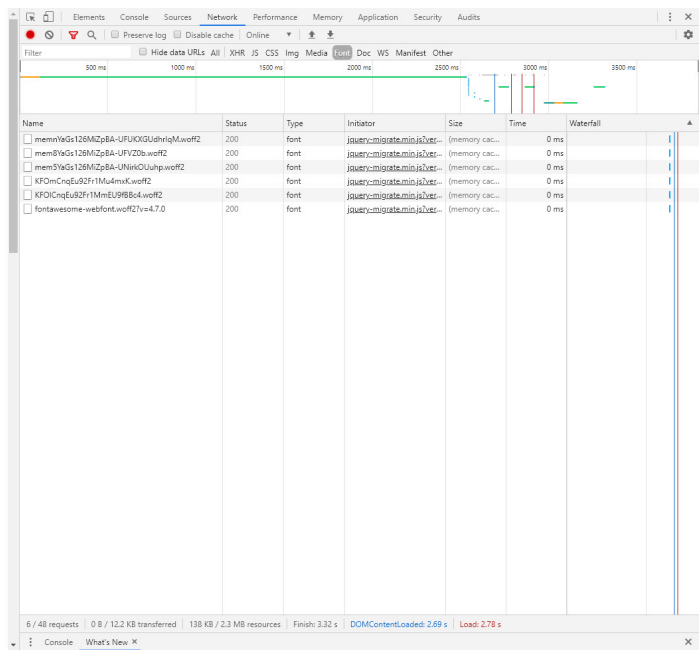
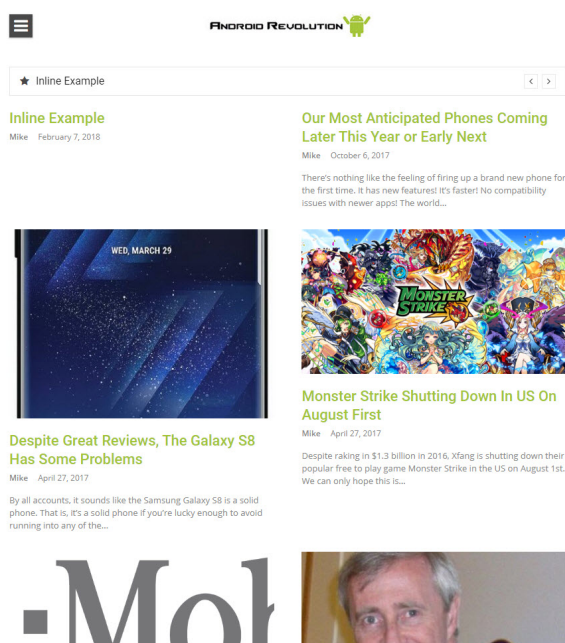
First, open your website in Google Chrome. Then, open DevTools by right-clicking on the page, then clicking Inspect.



Click on the Network tab in the DevTools panel, then click Font to view a list of your site's fonts.



If you don't see anything in the Fonts tab, refresh the page. You should then see a full list of loaded fonts.



Double-click the font files you want. A download prompt will appear. Save the files.

Follow the steps outlined [here](#) to add the downloaded font to your DigiOh account. Your custom font will now be available for use in pop-ups or inline forms, allowing you to design campaigns in line with your brand guidelines.

Didn't find the font files you were looking for on using the method above? It's possible your site uses Adobe fonts. You can check that by following these steps.

With Chrome Inspect still open, go into the Elements tab and search for "typekit".

If the search populates results, click through them and look for the <link> code that resembles this:
