

How to add Digioh Pop-ups and Forms to Webflow

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Webflow is a visual web design platform, CMS, and hosting provider. With Digioh, Webflow users can easily build website pop-ups, forms, and pop-ups.

Installing Digioh on Webflow Sites

To add Digioh campaigns to your Webflow site, follow these steps.

1) In Digioh, go to the [Setup Instructions](#) page to find your Digioh installation code.

2) Select and copy your installation snippet.

3) In Webflow, go to [Project settings](#) > [Custom Code](#). Paste the Digioh snippet into the Head Code text field.

Add Custom HTML & CSS

Adding custom code is sometimes needed for ultimate flexibility. You can save your progress by pressing Cmd+Shift+S (Ctrl+Shift+S on Windows).

Head Code

Save Changes

Add code at the end of the <head> tag:

4) Click Save Changes to save your code. Your changes will take effect the next time you publish your site.

5) All set! Your Digioh pop-ups and forms will now appear on your Webflow site.
