
Do you get an **Invalid Email Address** error even after the email address is valid?

This could be because of the wrong Payload configured in the field mappings.

Below is the basic payload for an iPost DataTable: `{ "Records": [{ "email_address": "[EMAIL]", "first_name": "[FIRST_NAME]", "last_name": "[LAST_NAME]" }] }` Update the payload to ensure that each iPost property aligns with the payload. Otherwise, you will get an error.
