Digioh's Monday.com integration allows you to capture leads with pop-up forms, pop-ups, surveys, and quizzes, The leads will be created as items in monday.com boards.

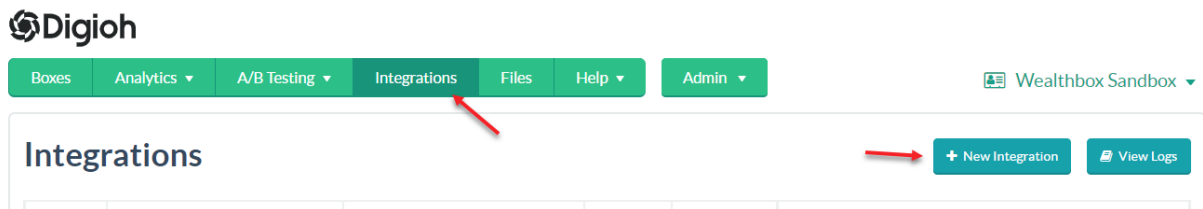
Integration Requirements:

- Monday.com API key
- Monday.com Board Id
- Monday.com Column Ids (These are fields ids that will pass from Digioh. [Here is Monday.com's Documentation on Column Ids if needed](#))

Steps

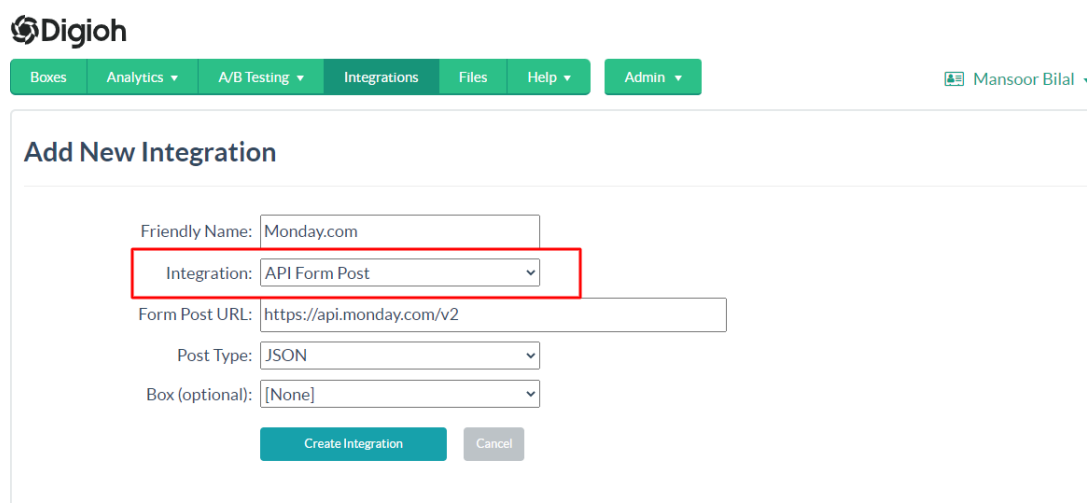
1: Add a New Integration



2: Set a friendly name in the Friendly Name field.

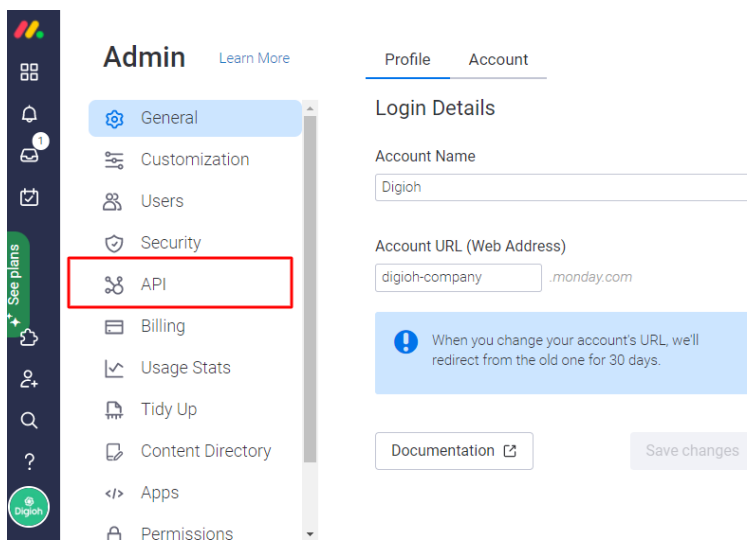
- 1- Login to Monday.com
- 2- Click on the Profile icon



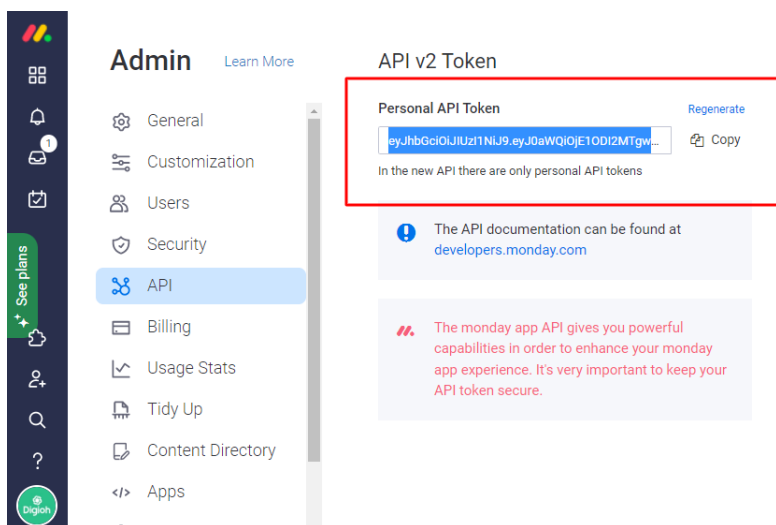
- ### 3- Then Click on Admin link

5- Generate and Copy the API Token

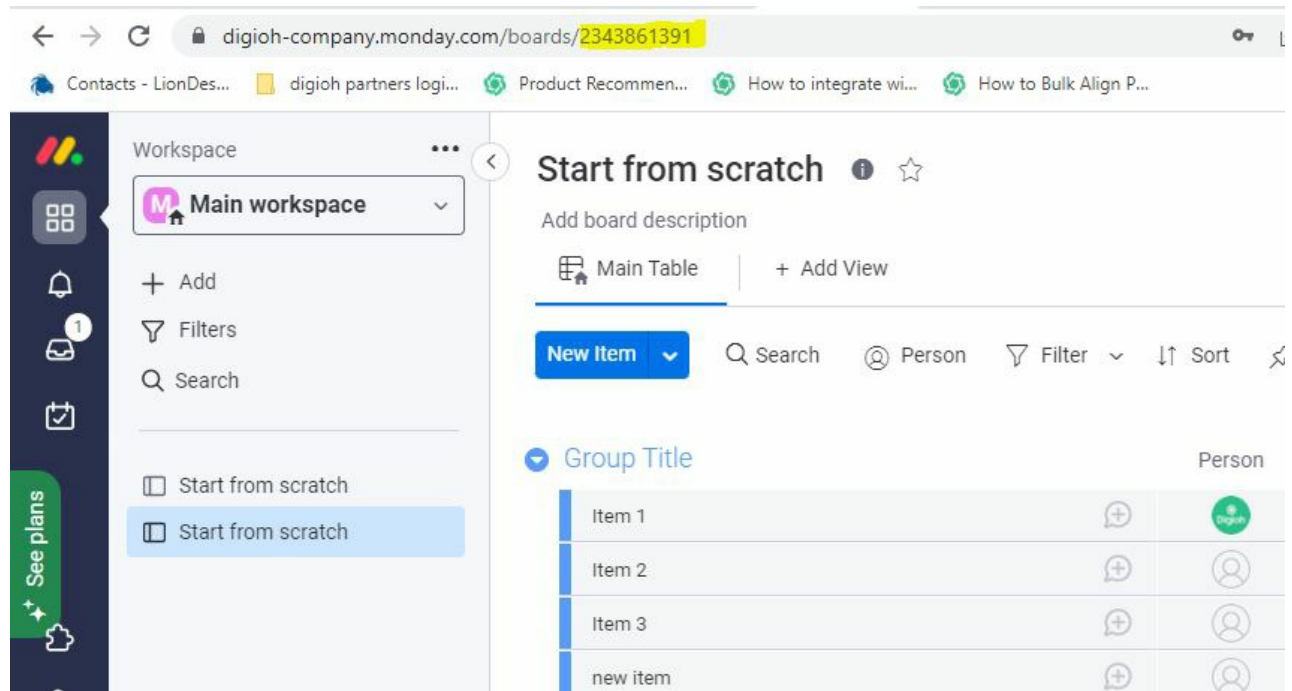


Set up your payload in the Raw Data to Send section.

In the above sample Payload, We are passing **board_id** (This is Board Id), **email**, **text**, **text1** are item Fields.

You can get the **board_id** from the URL.



Once you set up the payload Click on the **Save Advanced Settings** button.
