

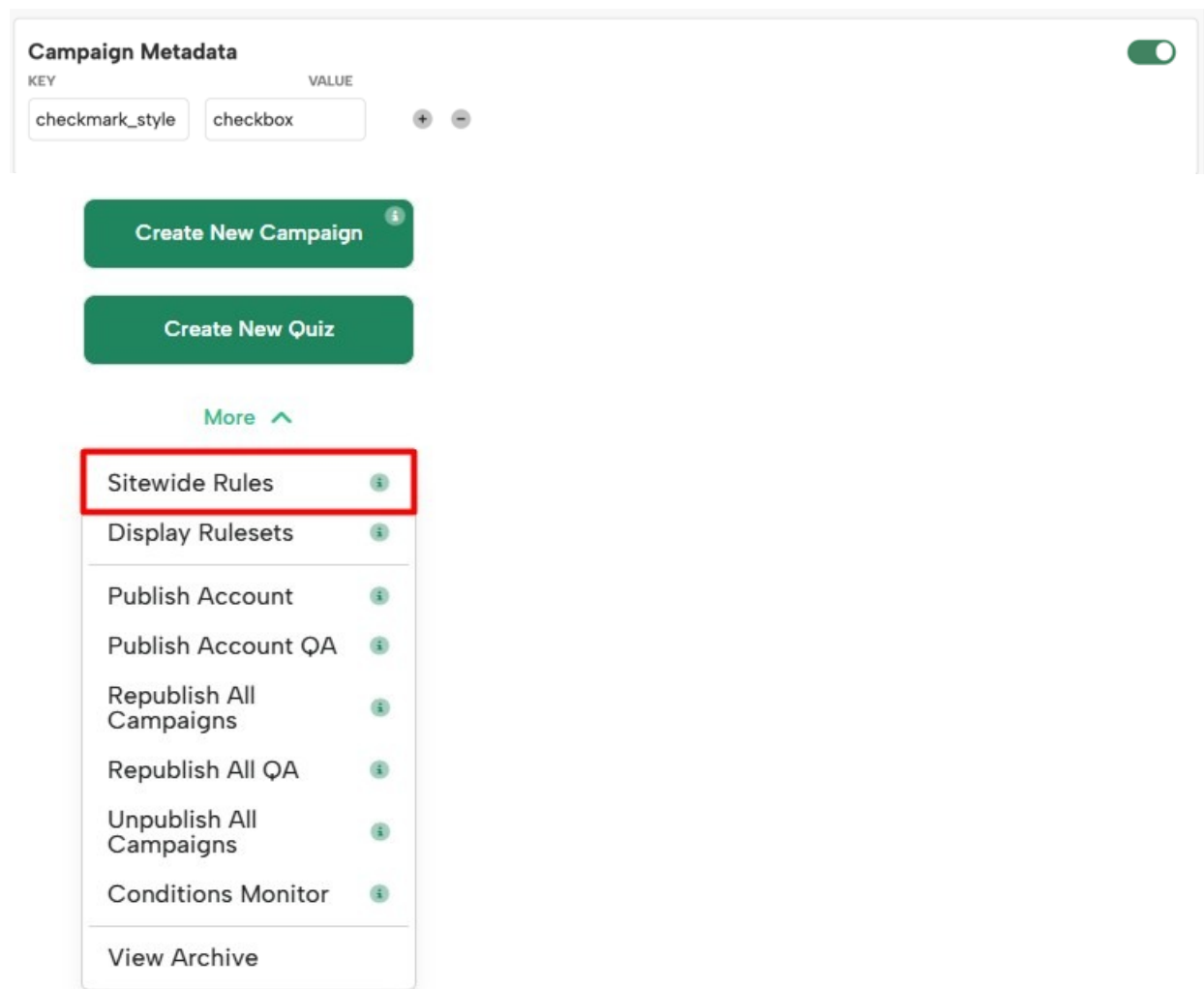
How to control multiple campaigns displaying simultaneously

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By default, Digioh shows only one campaign at a time. If the Display Rules pass for two campaigns, the highest-priority campaign appears first; when the visitor closes it, the second campaign appears. This guide explains how to allow campaigns to display at the same time *and* how to use the **Restrict Campaign Simultaneous Display** Extension to keep fine-grained control over which campaigns can co-display.

Step 1: Enable simultaneous display in your Sitewide Rule

In the campaign list, select **Sitewide Rules** under the **More** dropdown.



Enable "**Allow multiple campaigns to be displayed simultaneously.**" This turns off Digioh's default one-campaign-at-a-time restriction, so any campaigns whose Display Rules pass will show together.

Note: Enabling this setting without the Extension in Step 2 can lead to situations like two pop-up campaigns overlapping on screen. Follow Step 2 to add more targeted control.

Step 2: Install the Restrict Campaign Simultaneous Display Extension

Install this Extension to restore fine-grained control. It prevents pop-up campaigns from overlapping while still allowing the simultaneous display you enabled in Step 1.

1. Select **Extensions** under the account dropdown.
2. Find the "**Restrict Campaign Simultaneous Display**" extension.
3. Click **Install**, then **Publish** the Extension.

Once active, the Extension prevents two pop-up campaigns from ever displaying at the same time on a page.

Step 3: Fine-tune display restrictions per campaign (optional)

To control simultaneous display at the individual campaign level for banners and sidebars, add one of the following metadata values to a campaign via **Campaign Metadata**:

Metadata value	Behavior
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multidisplay_restrict	Prevents this campaign from opening if another campaign of the same type is already open (and vice versa).
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multidisplay_restrict	Prevents this campaign from opening if any restricted campaign is already open (and vice versa).

Note: Inline campaigns are exempt from these restrictions. Metadata applied to an Inline campaign has no effect.
