Webbula Integration Requirements

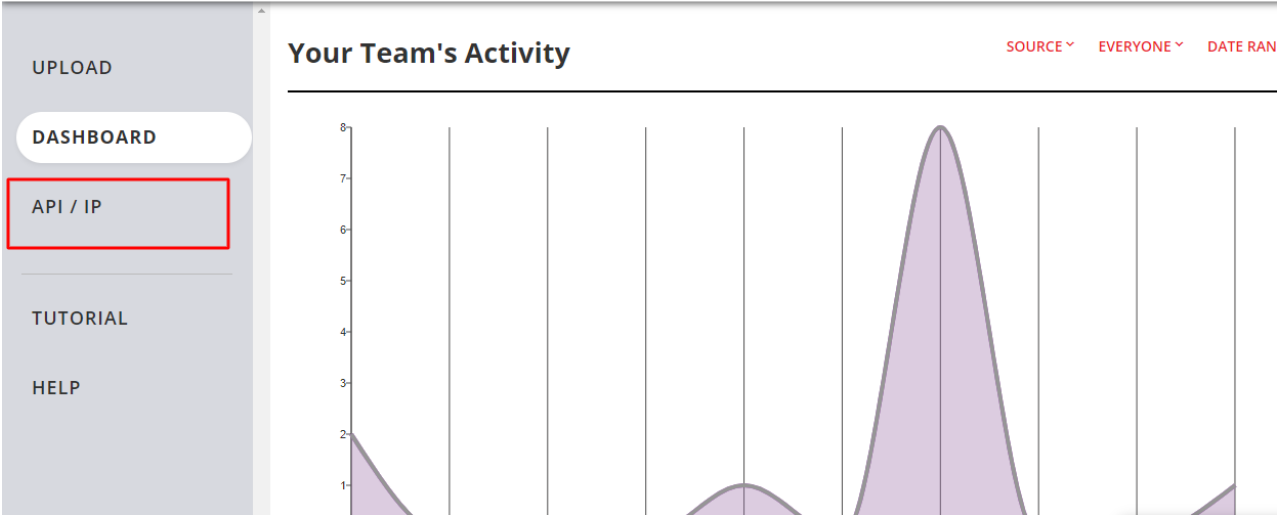
Before setting up your integration, you will need the following parameters from Webbula:

Getting an API Key:

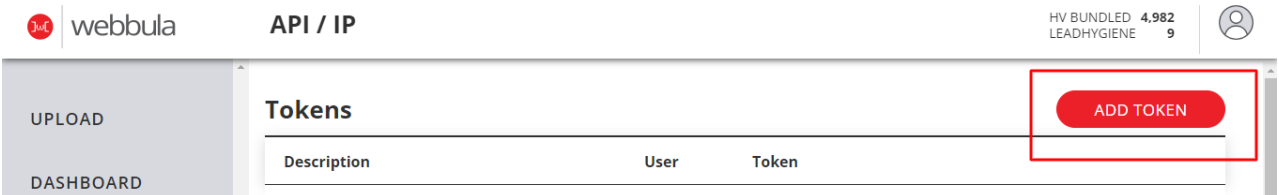
Log in to your Webbula account and create a new API Key.

Once logged in, select **API** from the left navigation.

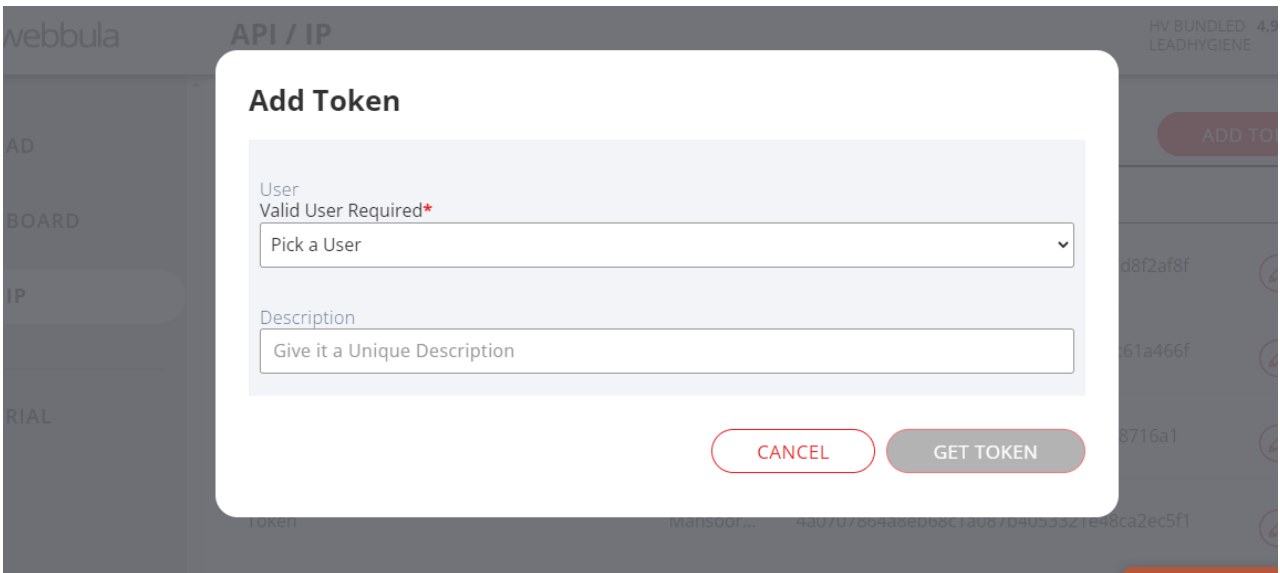
