


How to prevent a landing page from being indexed

If you have a Push Planet Landing Page that you'd prefer not be indexed by any search engines, that's very simple to setup!

In the page, open the SEO tab and add the following HTML to the HTML Head: **<meta name='robots' content='noindex'>**
