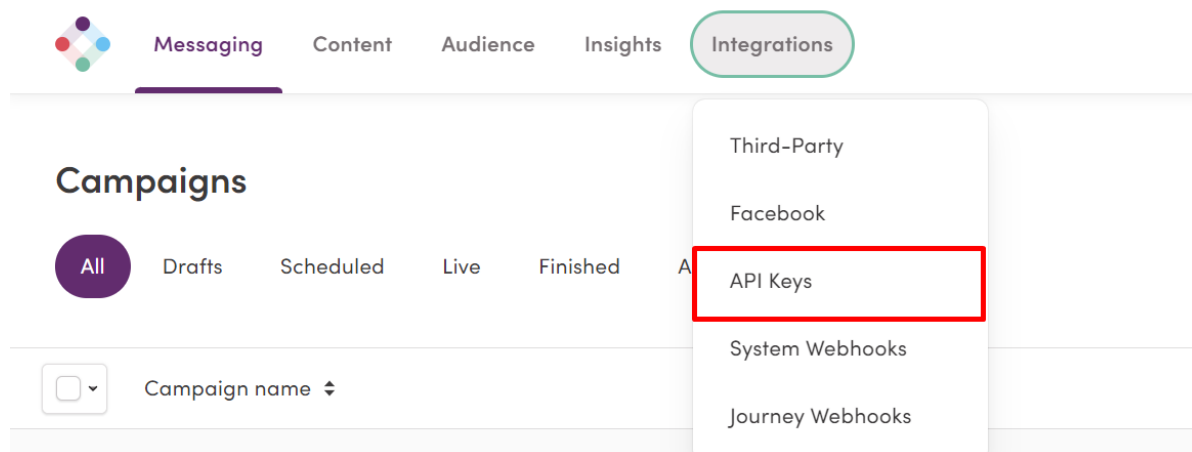


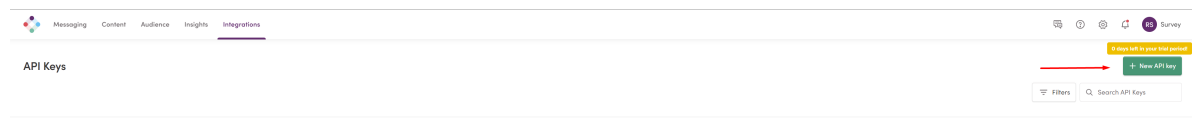
How do I Create an API Key in Iterable?

In your Iterable project, navigate to **Integrations > API Keys**. This screen lists information about each of the API keys that have been created for the project, but it does not display the full API keys.



From there, Click **New API Key**:



To integrate with Digioh, you'll need a **Server-Side API Key**. You should also provide a clear, recognizable name for the key:
